Sister Loyola Kapsner, O.S.B. became the new superior and principal of the school. Sister Loyola was the first "free" principal of St Anthony's.



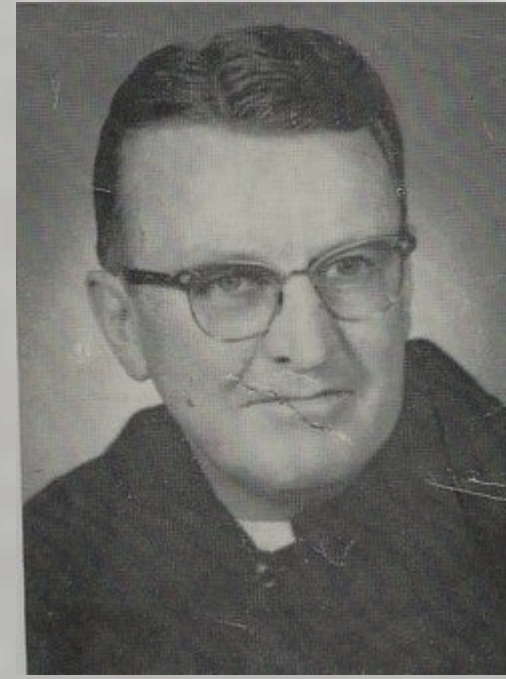
1932

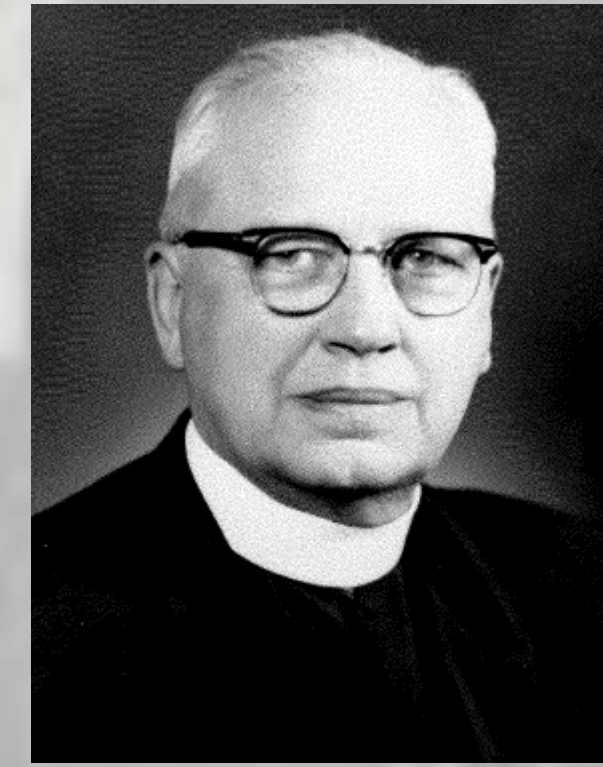


1934

St Anthony Church has grown from 150 to 400 families

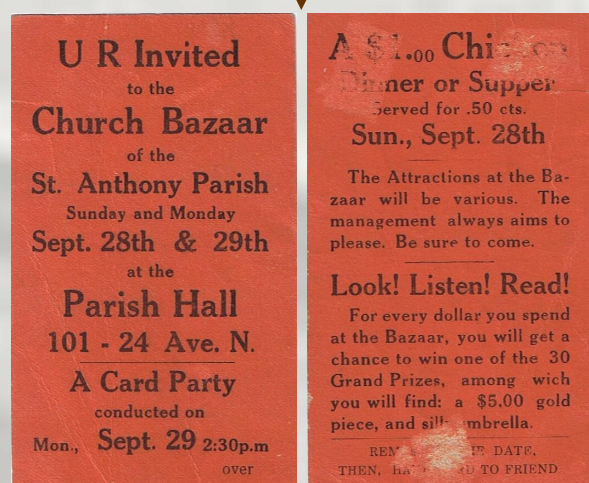


MAY 13, 1938

Father Hinnenkamp's 25th year anniversary celebration of his ordination attended by parishioners at original white frame church

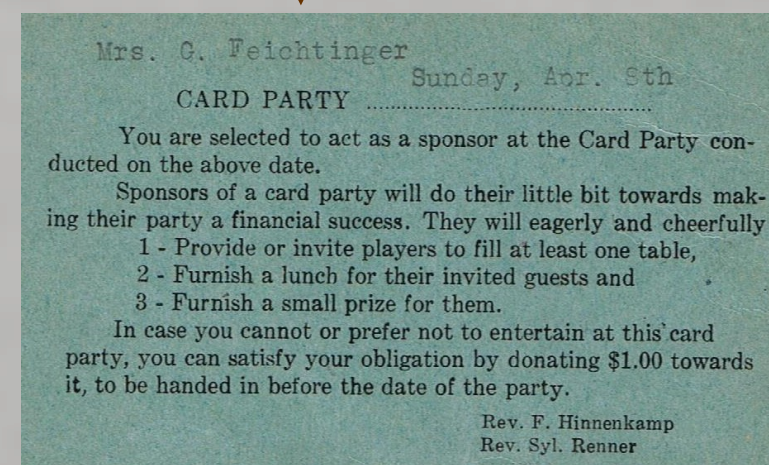


1933

Invitation from Fr. Hinnenkamp and Fr. Renner to Mrs. G Feichtinger to host the April 8th card party



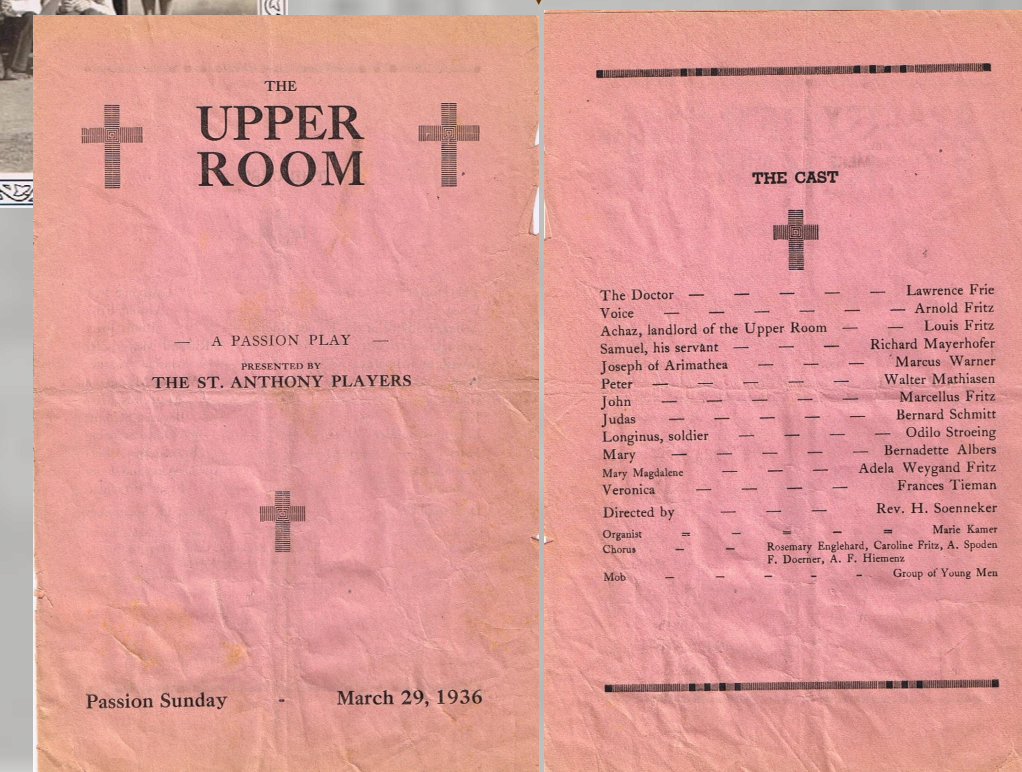
1934

St. Anthony's Harmonica Band led by Mr. Aloys Phillips



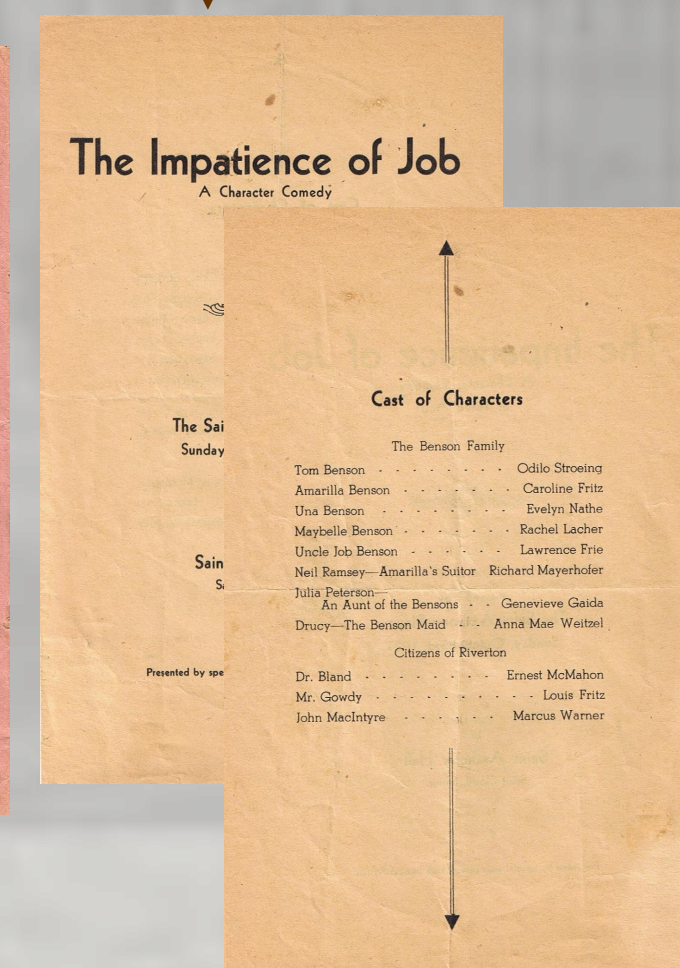
MAR 29, 1936

The Saint Anthony players presented "The Upper Room", a Passion play



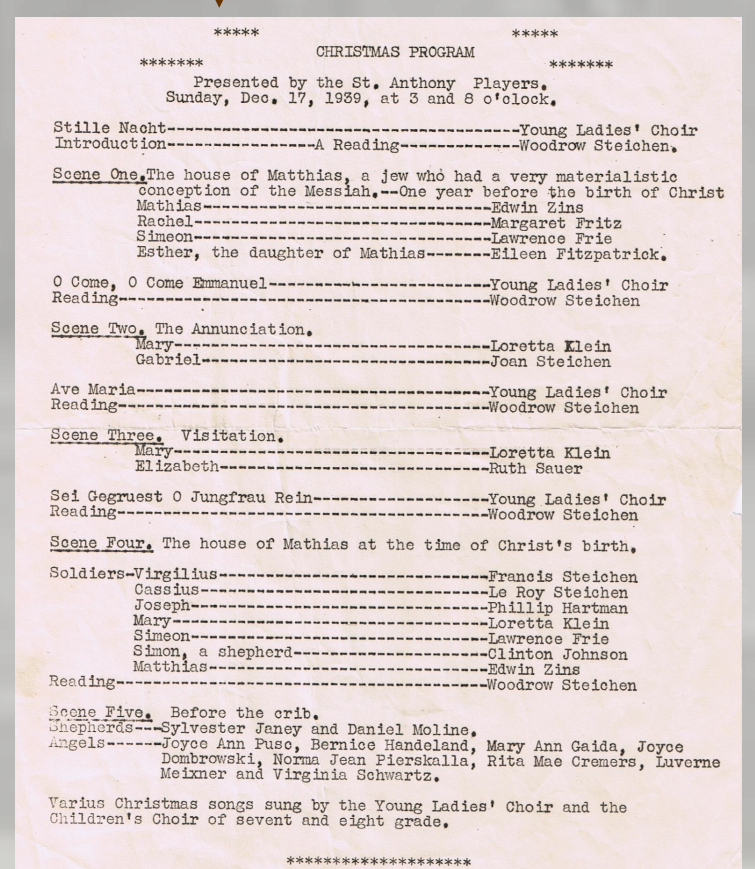
OCT 3, 1937
