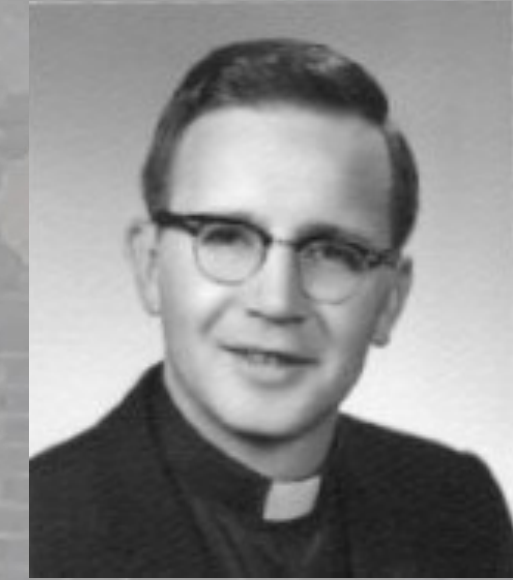

HOT LUNCH PROGRAM
We have been serving complete "hot lunches for a full month now. We don't always please everyone's taste, but the children seem to be happy with the meals. The cooks at Westwood are very good and the meals are tastefully prepared.
We have been asked why the 7th & 8th graders pay more for their meal than the other children. They are considered junior high students and the price for meals is 35¢ - grades 4th - junior high 45¢ - senior high 55¢
Also we do try to give larger portions to the older children.
Thank you for helping us by sending money once a week on Sunday. This helps in lessening the bookkeeping hours. The easiest method for us is a check per week from the entire family. But don't worry if you forget to send money, the children will get served anyway.
Please don't be offended if you receive a note saying you are behind in lunch money. If you ever disagree with my figures, call me at school or home. In keeping track of 300 kids (meals and money) I'm sure I make many mistakes.
I really enjoy working with your children. They are bunch of nice kids. But have you ever imagined the quantity of food? The lunch? 150 lunches in a morning. I sometimes feel like the commercial for two all beer parties, special sauce, lettuce, cheese, pickles, onions, on a sesame seed bun.

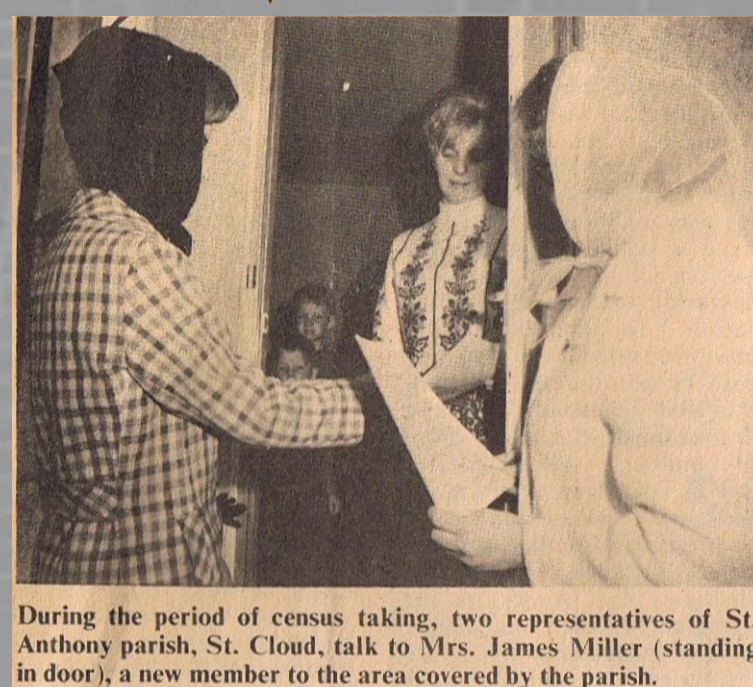

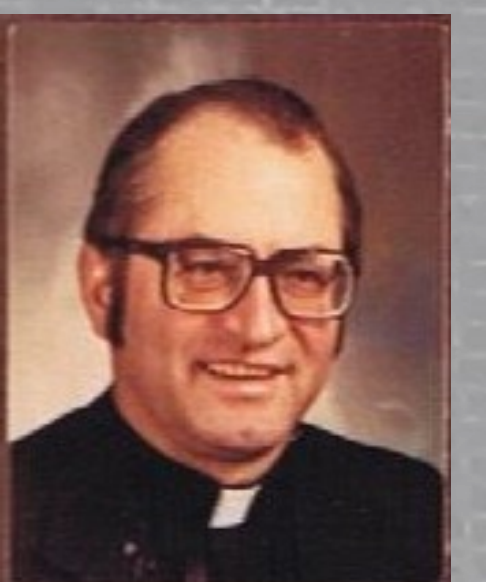
