DUTIES:

(FS)=2nd Collection for the Food Shelf

1. Arrive at least fifteen minutes before mass or PLEASE arrange for a substitute if you can not make it.
2. Watch for and assist individuals that need assistance getting into the building
3. Find someone to bring the gifts to the altar at the Offertory.
4. Help find open seats when church is crowded.
5. One or two ushers should wait in gathering area for about 5 minutes or so after the mass has started to help direct anyone who may come in after mass has started.
6. Sit as near as possible to side doors so as to offer assistance whenever necessary.
7. Take up collection.
8. Assure even flow from pews at the Eucharist and do headcount at designated Masses.
9. Handout bulletins after Mass. To comply with proper accounting regulations, two individuals should ensure that the collections has been placed in the safe.
